COUNTIES

RE: Mileage For Officials

This office is in receipt of your communication of December 27, 1955, wherein you give us your view as to the meaning of sections 11-1015 and 11-1512, dealing with the mileage of county officials.

This office is in accord with your construction, to the effect that no county official may charge mileage for transportation where he does not operate a vehicle, but travels along with other county officers. In other words, it is our opinion that you are right when you state that they must actually and necessarily incur the expense before they are permitted to collect mileage from the county.
